

This deed made this 1st day of August 1864, between Elizabeth Beale, Matthew Williams and his wife Eliza, Amanda Beale, Catharine Beale, Omaline Beale and Samuel Beale of the one part and Joshua Bryant of the second part, witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and fifty seven dollars and Sixty three cents, they do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Joshua Bryant a certain tract or parcel of land called by them "the old place" being the place upon which they formerly resided, owned formerly by William Beale deceased and bounded on the north by the road leading from Murphy's Depot to Joyner's Church, on the East by the road leading from Joyner's Church to Franklin Depot and the lands of Wiley A. and Sam'l H. Griffin and South by the lands of Said Wiley A. and Sam'l H. Griffin and others Eveline Drury, containing fifty one acres one half acre more or less, excepting and reserving our right to our half acre inclosing from the center of the grave yard, the right and title to all the rest of said land we do for the foregoing consideration, for a warrant and defund to the said Joshua Bryant.
