This Indenture made this thirtyfirst day of October in the year eighteen hundred and forty four, between William M. Beaton and Antonette M. his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first party and the Society of the Methodist Protestant Church of the second party. Witnesseth that the said party of the first party for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar to them the party of the first party in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has given granted bargained sold and conveyed, and does hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said party of the second party, forever or as long as they the said Society of the second party may or shall hold it or use it for Church purposes, and for no other purpose, a certain parcel of land on which is erected a Church by the name of Boykin's Chapel, lying in the County of Southampton, containing two acres more or less and lying on the Southward of Tarrara Creek and bounded as follows to w<sup>t</sup>. Commencing at the Southend of the bridge over Tarrara Creek thence along the run of the said Tarrara Creek east bound to a black gum, corner thence from black gum to Cypress South course, thence from said Cypress to Cypress west course, thence from said Cypress west course to Boykin's bridge road, thence along said road to the beginning of, to the southward of said bridge of said creek. The condition of the foregoing is such, to w<sup>t</sup>. that while the Society or party of the second party, attempts to use the property aforesaid for any other purpose, than as specified in the foregoing contract them the right and title of said property reverts back to the original owner otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
