This Indenture made this thirtieth day of October in the year eighteen hundred and sixty four, between William M. Beaton and Anniseth M. his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and the Society of the Methodist Protestant Church of the second part. Witnesseth that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar to them the party of the first part in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has given, granted, conveyed, sold and conveyed, and does hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said party of the second part, forever or as long as they the said Society of the second part may or shall hold it or use it for Church purposes, and for no other purpose, a certain parcel of land on which is erected a Church by the name of Boykins Chappell lying in the County of Southampton, containing two acres more or less and lying on the Southside of Tarrara Creek and bounded as follows to wit. Commencing at the Southend of the bridge over Tarrara Creek thence along the run of the said Tarrara Creek east course to a black gum corner thence from black gum to Cypress South course thence from said Cypress to Cypress west course thence from said Cypress west course to Boykins bridge road thence along said road to the beginning, to the Southend of said bridge of said Creek. The condition of the foregoing is such to wit. that when the Society or party of the second part, attempts to use the property aforesaid for any other purpose than specified in the foregoing contract then the right and title of said property revert back to the original owner otherwise to remain in full force and virtue. And the party of the first part for the consideration aforesaid, doth warrant generally the title of the property hereby conveyed. Witness the following signatures and seals.
