to the said Lucy J Bundall Isaac J Bundall and Robert T Bundall Trustee as aforesaid for the benefit of the said William
P Bundall infant child of Richard Bundall and Lucy E Bundall the wife of the said Richard Bundall all that
tract of land lying in the said County of Southhampton recently purchased by the said Waller from John Pines and
bounded by the lands of the heirs of Eleazer D Proctor dec^d George Miskell the heirs of Thomas Brown the heirs of
Samuel Barham and others containing six hundred and fifteen acres more or less and it is hereby covenanted and
agreed that the said Lucy E Bundall shall be permitted to live on the said tract of land hereby conveyed to the said
Robert T Bundall Trustee during her life and receive and enjoy the products and profits thereof and the said Levi C
Waller relinquishes to Lucy J Bundall Isaac J Bundall and Robert T Bundall Trustee as aforesaid for the benefit of
the said William P Bundall infant child of Richard Bundall and Lucy E Bundall wife of Richard Bundall all
