Kello Witnesseth that the said Samuel Kello acting as Commissioner & Sheriff by a decree of the Circuit Court of Southampton pronounced at November Term 1863 did grant bargain & sell unto the said Kinchen Gray the land and premises therein mentioned known as the Apple Branch tract of land & adjoining the lands of Joseph S. This Deed made the twenty second day of February in the year eighteen hundred and sixty four between Tho. B. Powell Commissioner and Jno. R. Jones Witnesseth that in consideration of thirty four hundred dollars the said Tho. B. Powell as Commissioner do grant and convey unto the said Jno. R. Jones all his right, title and interest in a certain tract of land situated in the County of Southampton Va. containing three hundred and fifty acres, be the same more or less, and bounded on the south by the lands of J. O. Harris dec^d and John Harris dec^d and North by the lands of said W. T. Adams and Kinchen Williams dec^d The said Tho. B. Powell covenants with the said Jno. R. Jones that he will warrant generally the property hereby conveyed. Witness our signatures as Commissioner.

This Deed made and entered into this the 25th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty four (1864) between Nwist Branch and Elenor Branch his wife parties of the first part and William F. Lane of the second part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Nwist B. Branch and Elenor his wife of the first part (grantors) for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and twenty five dollars in hand paid to them, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do grant and convey unto the said William F. Lane of the second part (grantee) a certain parcel of tract of land lying in Southampton County known as the "Harris tract" containing fifty one acres more or less, and bounded on the West by the lands of John B. Barrett, on the South by the lands belonging to the estate of Wm. R. Stephenson, known as the "Miles Scarborough tract" on the East by the lands of Ford Coopers, on the North by the lands of Widow Sally Raiford. To have and to hold the said land unto the said William F. Lane, to him and his heirs forever. And the said parties of the first part do covenant that the said William F. Lane shall have possession of said land, and they do further agree that they will warrant generally the property hereby conveyed.
