Holloman died by deed bearing date April 15<sup>th</sup> 1864 and admitted to record in the Blanks Office of Southampton County on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of April 1864 which will appear by reference to said deed, in consideration of the sum of Eight thousand dollars, grant and convey unto the said Robert S. Morris, all his right, title and interest in all his lands lying in Southampton County most of which are therein particularly described, and whereas the said Octavia wife of the said George A. Holloman did not convey her interest in said lands mentioned in the aforesaid deed of April 15<sup>th</sup> 1864, and now being desirous of conveying her interest in all of said lands to the said Robert S. Morris, this deed therefore witnesseth, that the said George A. Holloman and Octavia his wife grantors, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight thousand dollars to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do grant and convey unto the said Robert S. Morris his heirs and assigns, all the lands lying in Southampton County Va. which lands the said George A. Holloman heretofore from his father George H. Holloman, said lands described somewhat in the following manner. 1<sup>st</sup> the "Jack Holloman tract" on which Wm B. Hall now resides and bounded on the West by the "Proctors Road" on the East by the lands of P. J. Holmes and James B. Urquharts estate, On the South by the said Urquharts estate, On the North by the lands of R. D. Bailey and P. J. Holmes said tract containing one hundred and fifty acres more or less. 2<sup>nd</sup> the "Sylvia Holloman tract" bounded on the East by the "Proctors Road" on the South by Crumplers, John, lands, on the West by the lands of R. G. Drew, on the North by the lands of Robert D. Bailey, said tract containing One hundred acres more or less. 3<sup>rd</sup> the "Washington tract" bounded on the South by the lands of Polly Branch, on the North by the lands of Henry D. Bailey, on the East by the lands of Robert Nelson and Moses Warren, on the West by the Proctors Road, and intersected by said road.
