This Deed made this the 10th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and sixty five, between George A. Holloman of the one part and Robert T. Morris
of the other part, both of the County of Surrey and State of Virginia. Witnesseth, that in considera-
tion of the sum of one thousand dollars, the said George A. Holloman doth grant unto the said Robert
T. Morris and to his heirs and assigns all his lands lying in the County of Southampton Virginia,
which lands he inherited from the estate of his father George A. Holloman, said lands described some-
what in the following manner - 1^o the "Jack Holloman tract" on which Wm. B. Hall now resides, and in
which Fanny E. Hall has a donor interest, most of said tract of land lying on the East side of Proctors
road leading to Jerusalem Va. and bounded by the lands of James B. Urquhart, Robert J. Bailey and
Peter Holmes, said tract of land containing one hundred and fifty acres more or less. 2^o the "Sly
Holloman tract" on which Mrs. Gwaltney now resides, said tract lying on the West side of Proctors road,
and bounded respectively by the lands of J. P. Drew, Jas. Crumpler and Robt. J. Bailey. Said tract containing
one hundred acres more or less. 3^o the "Washington tract" intersected by the said Proctors Road and
bounded by the lands of Henry A. Bailey, Lucy C. Preston, Robert Nelson, Polly Branch and Moses
Warren, containing fifty acres more or less. 4^o the "Bumble tract" intersected by the Norfolk & Petersburg
Rail Road and bounded by the lands of Jas. Crumpler, James B. Urquhart and Nancy Taylor, containing
thirty acres more or less, all of which lands herein described, the said George A. Holloman doth grant and
convey unto unto the said Robert T. Morris, to have and to hold the same to him and his heirs forever.
The said George A. Holloman covenants that the said Robert T. Morris shall have quiet possession
of all said lands. And the said George A. Holloman further agrees that he will warrant generally the
property hereby conveyed. Witnesseth the following signatures to seal the day and year aforesaid.
