L. Drew and Albinia A. Edwards, all her right title and interest in the real estate lying in the County of  
Southampton Va. of which her husband Benjamin L. Drew died, seized and possessed, it being her lower right  
the said real estate bounded somewhat as follows, to wit, by the lands of Thomas A. Thompson, Robert J. Bailey  
Joseph W. Hart, Littleton Hart, To have and to hold all her right title and interest in said real estate hereby  
granted unto the said Benjamin L. Drew and Albinia A. Edwards their heirs and assigns forever. And the  
said Lavinia Drew further covenants that she will warrant generally the interest hereby conveyed. Witnesseth the
