Allen Edwards of the first part and Robert M. Edwards of the second part, all of the County of Southampton
and State of Virginia, Witnesseth, that whereas the said Allen Edwards is indebted to the said Robert M.
Edwards as his guardian, and the said Robert M. Edwards is desirous of purchasing from the said Allen
Edwards the plantation herein after conveyed and described, for the sum of four thousand five hundred
dollars, which is to be considered as part payment of the amount due from the said Allen Edwards to him as
guardian, Now in consideration of the foregoing and of the said sum of four thousand five hundred
dollars, the said Allen Edwards does hereby grant, sell and convey unto the said Robert M. Edwards
the following parcel or tract of land lying and situated in the County aforesaid, containing by estimation
four hundred and fifty acres and bounded and described as follows. On the East by the line of marked trees
mentioned in the deed to Richard G. Edwards made this day, on the North by Wm. G. Stephenson's land
on the West by Alfred T. Stephenson's land and on the South by Zachariah C. Johnson's and Robert Rufford's
land, it being the plantation on which the said Allen Edwards resides at this time, with the exception of
the part this day conveyed to Richard G. Edwards. And the said Allen Edwards does hereby covenant
with the said Robert M. Edwards that he is seized in fee of the foregoing premises: that they are free from
all incumbrances, and that he will forever warrant and defend the title to the same against the lawful
