Proctor a tract of land in Southampton County near Frankfort, containing (110) One hundred and ten acres more or less and bounded by the lands of Jordan Edwards, Richard Barrett and John Camp. And the said Joshua Proctor and Ann C. his wife do covenant with the said Jane W. Proctor that he will warrant generally to her the tract of land hereby conveyed.
