Southampton County Court - Also the said Dardens interest in the estate of Richard Darden the late of Southampton - also his the said Dardens interest in the debts due the late from doing business in Southampton & elsewhere in the name and style of Darden & Nickl - also all the bonds and accounts and other choses in action due the said Richard J. Darden from all and every person or persons whatever. & also all the said Richard J. Darden Stocks of horses mules, cattle, sheep, hogs and their flocks & increase, farming implements of every kind, one carriage, buggy, harness, Wagons, carts, plows &c. One still & worm, cider casks & apple mill - all his present growing crops and in this is intended to embrace such portions of crops as may be coming to him from his tenants. One other bond due Thomas Ridley by bond executed March 1<sup>st</sup> 1856 for one thousand dollars to which J. J. Darden, H. P. Pope are securities and on which the interest has been paid to Sept. 1<sup>st</sup> 1857. one other bond to Thos. Ridley executed Feb. 1<sup>st</sup> 1854 for \$1676. 03cts to which J. J. Darden & H. P. Pope are securities and on which the interest is paid to Sept. 1<sup>st</sup> 1857 - one other bond to Thos. Ridley executed August 6<sup>th</sup> 1857 & due Sept. 1<sup>st</sup> 1857 for \$1437. 73 to which J. J. Darden is security. One bond executed by Darden Clarke to Thos. Ridley the 30<sup>th</sup> August 1852 for \$2200. to which J. J. Darden & H. P. Pope are securities and on which interest is paid to September 1<sup>st</sup> 1857. One bond due H. P. Myrick for four Eight hundred and ten thousand dollars (the date & precise amount not recollecting) and to which it is believed (as) J. J. Darden is security but not certain. One bond executed to George C. Pope (which has been assigned Ben. E. Pope) the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1851, for \$1613. 72 cb. One bond executed to Ben. E. Pope Feb. 20, 1855 for \$485. subject to a credit of \$21. 25 paid Aug 1<sup>st</sup> 1856. Another bond executed to Ben. E. Pope guardian of Sally J. Darnley on 21<sup>st</sup> Jan 1857 due 1<sup>st</sup> Aug 1857 for \$232. 24cb. One bond executed to H. P. Pope guardian of Rufel P. Joseph B. Pope on 16<sup>th</sup> May 1859 for \$581. 49 cb. with interest from 25 February 1859. another bond executed to H. P. Pope guardian as aforesaid on 19<sup>th</sup> March 1860 for \$363. 61 cb. with interest from 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1860 and another bond executed to H. P. Pope guardian of Susan Afognon on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of February 1858 for \$336. 91 cb. with interest from 1<sup>st</sup> January 1858. And the trustee may make sale of the property publicly or privately for each or upon a credit as he may think best for the interest of the parties. And it is hereby agreed and covenanted between the parties hereto, the monies arising from the property of or used & the collection of the debts (and the trustee is hereby authorized & directed to proceed to collect the same) herein before conveyed after paying all costs & expenses attending this trust shall pay first the debts due Thomas Ridley & H. P. Myrick herein before named or referred to, and all other debts of any, to which Ben. E. Pope, H. P. Pope & J. J. Darden or either of them are security for Richard J. Darden - Secondly pay the debts herein before named due Ben. E. Pope & H. P. Pope both as guardians and individually - Thirdly the balance if any, pay & satisfy all other debts due from the said Richard J.
