for \$2200. to which Jas. J. Darden & H. P. Pope are securities & on which interest is paid to September 1<sup>st</sup> 1857.  
One bond due M<sup>rs</sup>. C. Myrick for from Eight hundred to one thousand dollars (the date & price amount not recollecting)  
and to which it is believed Jas. J. Darden is security, but not certain. One bond executed to George C. Pope (which  
has been assigned Ben. E. Pope) the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1861 for \$1613.72 ch. One bond executed to Ben. E. Pope  
Feb. 20. 1855 for \$485. Subject to a credit of \$21.38 paid June 1<sup>st</sup> 1856. Another bond executed to Ben. E. Pope  
guardian of Sally J. Dudley on 21<sup>st</sup> Jan. 1857 due 1<sup>st</sup> June 1857 for \$232.24 ch. One bond executed to H. P. Pope  
Guardian of Rufus B. Pope on 16 May 1859 for \$581.49 ch. with interest from 25 February 1859.

chattel estate of every kind and description including a suit now pending in the Circuit Court for  
Southampton County against William Holt Subject to all prior deeds or said property, he is to and to  
secure John M. Gurley from all loss as the security of the said Gurley for the faithful <sup>discharge</sup> of his duties as the  
Guardian of W. J. Johnson a minor under the age of twenty one - Witnesseth the
