Holliman and Allen his wife do grant, sell, convey, general warranty to said Wm. P. Underwood trustee as aforesaid the following property to wit: All their interest, right and title to the following tracts or parcels of land lying and being in Surry County Virginia, Viz: a tract of three hundred and forty eight acres of land adjoining the lands of Edwin White, Adkins tract and others, a tract of land known as Moorhead containing three hundred and nine acres, adjoining the lands of Edwin White, T. C. Atkinson, Arthur Hollimans estate and others, also a tract of land known as Cherry Hill tract containing one hundred acres and three quarters adjoining Oakland Alex.
