dollars and of what followeth they the said Richard A. Holloman and Allie his wife do grant and sell
general warantly to said Wm. P. Underwood trustee as aforesaid the following property to wit, all their
interest, right and title to the following tracts or parcels of land lying and being in Surry County
Virginia, vizt a tract of three hundred and forty-eight acres of land adjoining the lands of Edwin White,
Flocke's tract and others, a tract of land known as Aberdeen containing three hundred and nine acres,
adjoining the lands of Edwin White, T. C. Atkinson, Arthur Holloman estate and others, also a tract
of land known as Cherry Holt tract containing one hundred acres and three quarters adjoining Oaklawn
Mtn. Faison and others. by said quantities of land more or less - also all his interest in and to a mill &
fixtures known as Proffers mill in the County of Southampton, and the following personal property Viz.
