Not neglecting, that for and in consideration of the love & affection which the parties of the first part have bears for their sons-in-law & daughters - the parties of the second part, & the further consideration of one dollar to them in hand paid, at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, they, the said Thos Ridley & Margaret A. B. his wife, have given, granted, bargained, sold & confirmed, & do, by these presents, give, grant, bargain, sell & confirm unto the said Jos. W. Urquhart & M. J. Urquhart his wife & their heirs, & A. B. Urquhart & C. A. Urquhart his wife & their heirs, the tract of land known as "Boykin Farm" lying and being in the County of Southampton, Virginia & North Carolina, consisting of one thousand fifty acres more or less, bounded as follows, to wit, beginning at Boykins bridge, on the Meherrin River, & bounded by the road leading from said bridge to Boykins Depot, on the north by a branch, which constitutes the line between the Boykins tract & Henry's Hundreds estate, on the east by the lands belonging to the estate of Oscar Morrell & of Henry Castle due on the south by the Meherrin River, for a more particular description of which, reference is hereby made to deeds from A. T. Williams & W. H. Phillips, to Geo. B. Cary, of record in the Clerks Office of the County Court of Southampton, to have and to hold the said tract of land in joint tenancy. The said J. W. Urquhart & M. J. Urquhart his wife & their heirs to be seized of one undivided moiety of the whole & the said A. B. Urquhart & C. A. Urquhart his wife & their heirs to be seized of the other undivided moiety of the whole, and the said parties of the first part covenant to warrant and defend, forever, the premises hereby conveyed against the claim or claims of any tall persons whatsoever.
