This deed made this the 30th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty six (1866) between Mary C. Wills, grantor, of the one part and John J. Wills, grantee, of the other part, both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia; Witnesseth, that the said Mary C. Wills, for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred dollars (\$500) in hand paid by the said John J. Wills, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth grant and convey unto the said John J. Wills, all that tract of land lying in the County of Southampton on which she now resides containing about three hundred and sixty acres more or less, and bounded by the lands of Levi Hindley's estate, Wm. Drake, Amos Joyner, Eliza Harris and Zachariah Doyal, the said lands to have and to hold to him and his heirs forever. And the said Mary C. Wills doth warrant generally the property hereby conveyed.
