

This Deed made this ninth day of August, in the year, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six, between Robert Ricks (grantor), of the first part, and Ino: I. Kindred (Trustee) of the second part, Witneseth, that the said Robert Ricks for and in consideration of the promises hereinafter stated, doth grant and convey to the said Ino: I. Kindred, the following property to wit, all that tract or parcel of land lying in Southampton County and commonly known as the quarter of the said Ricks, supposed to contain six hundred and thirty acres, more or less and bounded by the Etawaway River, by the lands of Benjamin Dwyer, William Cobb, Arthur Gardner, Bennett Evans & others. In trust to secure the payment of the following debts due by the said Robert Ricks - In the first place, and before any other debts, one bond executed for one thousand dollars to Benj: E. Pope in or about the year 1859, to which Iph: B. Vick^{is} Surety - one other bond executed for the like amount of one thousand dollars about the same year, to Thomas Ridd, to which the said Iph: B. Vick^{is} also Surety - and all other debts due by the said Robert Ricks, to which the said Iph: B. Vick^{is} or any other person may be bound as Surety, whether specially mentioned herein or not, are to be paid before any others - And afterwards, in the second class, all other debts which may be justly owing by the said Ricks, to whomsoever due.

The said Robert Ricks reserves herein all such relief and protection as may now or may hereafter be afforded by any "Stay Law" or any other law State or federal -

If a sale of the said property should be necessary the said trustee is to make sale on the following terms, to wit, One third of the purchase money to be paid in cash and the remainder in two equal annual instalments; bonds with personal security to be taken and the title to be retained until the whole of the purchase money is paid - The land to be sold at auction, in one lot or parcel or divided into two or more lots or parcels as may be deemed most advantageous for the creditors of the said Ricks, by himself or by his personal representative.

This Deed made this the 17th day of August one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six between Mr H. Prichard Commissioner of the first part and Zachariah Doyle of the 2d^o part both of the County of Southampton and State of Va. Witneseth, that Whereas by virtue of a decree of the Circuit Court of Southampton County entered at its May Term 1864, in the case of joyner v. H. H. Hunday, it was deemed amongst other things that the said Commissioner after collecting the bonds for the purchase money of the real estate in the proceedings mentioned, should execute to the purchaser a deed with special warranty for the said real estate; and whereas Zachariah Doyle the purchaser of a tract known as the Jack Hunday tract of which Levi Hunday died seized and possessed has paid to the said Commissioner the sum amount of three and interest to the sum of \$261.54 executed by him for the purchase of said tract. Now therefore this deed Witneseth, that for and in consideration of the promises, the said Mr H. Prichard Commissioner as aforesaid does grant and convey unto Zachariah Doyle the said tract of land known as the Jack Hunday tract containing one hundred acres more or less of which Levi Hunday died seized and possessed.
