Bryant of the other part Witneseth, that the said James Barnes by order and authority vested in him as Executor as aforesaid by the last Will and Testament of the said Ispe Ferguson which said was admitted to probate at the Circuit Court Term A.D. 1865 of the County Court of Southampton County State of Virginia do hereby grant and convey to the said Gordy C. Whitfield and Charles E. Bryant who were the purchasers of the real estate of the said Ispe Ferguson dec'd and by him described in his said last Will to be sold and which was purchased by the said Gordy C. Whitfield and Charles E. Bryant at public auction for the sum of five hundred and ninety dollars, the receipt of one hundred ninety six dollars & Sixty seven cents that being one third of Gordy C. Whitfield and the receipt of three hundred and ninety three dollars & thirty three cents of Charles E. Bryant that being two thirds the amount each one proportionably part making the aggregate amount of five hundred and ninety dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged - all that tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton State of Va on which the said Ispe Ferguson died seated to itself of and adjoining the lands of John A.
