Darden, all the household and kitchen furniture of the said Parker of every description whatsover: Now Trust to secure and save harmless Geo. H. Gurley, Harrison D. Moore, William W Briggs and Wm. R. Parker, Securities of the said James W Parker as guardian for Frederick S. Parker, which said guardian bond alluded to was executed at May Term of the County Court of the said County at the May term thereof A. D. 1854. It is the intention of this deed to secure the payment of whatever may be due to the said Frederick S. Parker on a final settlement of his guardians account, in the first place and before all other debts, and in the second place and lastly, to secure and save harmless all other persons who may be surety for the said James W Parker in any instance whatever, to wit Geo.
