

This Indenture made and entered into this 25<sup>th</sup> day of August eighteen hundred and Sixty six, 1866, between Dennis Bryant and Braxton B Bryant, both of the County of Southampton Virginia, witnesseth, that the s<sup>t</sup> Dennis Bryant for the sum of Eight hundred dollars (\$800), paid to him in hand by the s<sup>t</sup> Braxton B Bryant, grant bargained and sold to the s<sup>t</sup> Braxton B Bryant two tracts or parcels of land one where he now lives of Fifty acres 50. and bound as follows by Benjamin B Kindred on the South, on the West and at other by William T Bryant and on the East by Joseph Gray's land, and the other tract or parcel known by the James Gray's tract and also bound as follows on the North by Leslie Bryant, by John Hilliard on East, the Sweethouse Swamp on the South, Joseph Gray's land on the West, with all the improvements there belonging to the said tract of land containing Eighty acres more or less. On Witness whereunto I do set my hand and affix my seal the day and year above written.

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This Deed made this 14<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year 1866, between James R Joyner and Wm A Joyner of the one part and John W Harrison of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said James R Joyner and Wm A Joyner doth grant grant unto the said John W Harrison with general warranty, the following property, to wit, all that portion or part of the tract of land on which the said James R Joyner and Wm A Joyner now live lying on the South side of the Seaboard and Roanoke Rail Road embracing all the appurtenances thereto belonging, lying in the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, containing by estimation twelve hundred acres to be the same now or less, and bounded on the North by the Seaboard and Roanoke Rail Roads and by the lands of Joseph M. T. Rogers & his T. James d<sup>r</sup>, on the west and by the late John T. Branch on the South and Benj. B Kindred on the East, and also the entire interest of the said Jas. R Joyner and Wm A Joyner in all the lands sold the said Joyner, Benj. W Goodwin and Thomas Ridley by the late John T. Branch d<sup>r</sup> lying in the County of Southampton, State of Virginia as will more fully appear by reference to the records of Southampton County, also all the chattel interests of the said Jas. R Joyner and Wm A Joyner consisting of their Stock of horses, mules, cattle, sheep and hog and their future increase, household and kitchen furniture, Wagons, carts wheels, gear and farm implements, Crops of Corn, fodder Cotton Trees and Potatoes. In trust to secure the following debts and interest due from E Pops, one bond executed by James R Joyner d<sup>r</sup>, dated and due Sept. the 10<sup>th</sup> 1854 for fifteen hundred dollars, one bond executed by Jas. R Joyner, James R Joyner and Wm A Joyner for three hundred and twenty nine  $\frac{9}{10}$  Dollars due Sept 1<sup>st</sup> 59 and dated Sept. 19/59. One bond executed by James R Joyner, Wm A Joyner and George T James for four hundred and eighty  $\frac{9}{10}$  Dollars dated January the 16<sup>th</sup> 1860 and due at and after the 1<sup>st</sup> 1860, one other bond executed by James R Joyner and Wm A Joyner for five thousand dollars dated and due September the 14<sup>th</sup> 1866, and it is hereby covenanted and agreed between the parties to this deed, that no sale shall take place under this deed without the consent of the said Jas. R Joyner and Wm A Joyner prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1869, and that when a sale does take place, should one be necessary, then the property herein named shall be sold for cash, after giving twenty days notice, and the proceeds after paying the costs and expenses of this trust shall be applied to the payment of the aforesaid debts and interest.
