 party of the second part for the sum of thirty four hundred and sixty three dollars, the receipt of which is hereby
 acknowledged, all their right, title and interest to the farm known as Rokeastle, in the County of Southampton
 State of Virginia, containing about seven hundred acres, to be the same more or less, except one acre which is
 now used as a burying ground, and bounded by the lands of G. S. Masgrave, the heirs of Geo. C. Briggs, the heirs
 of Chas. Sykes &c. The said party of the first part specially state that there is an unextinguished claim to a dower
 interest in a portion of said land by Sarah Booth and that the said party of the first part do not want
 grant the title nor defend it against said claim but against all other claims whatever the title to said
