

Franklin Depot Va July 29<sup>th</sup> 1866

This Indenture entered into this day between Joseph B Crumpler of the first part and Allen Edwards representative of the estate of R. B. Edwards dec<sup>d</sup>. Junius W Edwards son of said dec<sup>d</sup>. and Sarah A Edwards widow of said R. B. Edwards of the second part, Witnesseth that said Joseph B Crumpler of the first part occupant and present owner of the house and premises of said R. B. Edwards, at Franklin Depot Southampton County Va agrees to put such repairs and improvements on said premises of said R. B. E's. est. as may be designated by said Allen Edwards or by Junius W Edwards or by Sarah A Edwards parties of the second part to this contract who on their part agrees to pay Joseph B Crumpler of the first part for the amount expended with lawful interest from that time inured until paid whenever he produces proper vouchers of expenditures and costs &c. and further binds themselves to appropriate the annual rent, and said premises, to the liquidation of said debt until paid, In testimony whereof the contracting parties affix their hands and seals as above

Francis and others, together with all its fixtures appurtenances thereto belonging, the said James D H Drury has this day paid the said James Drury the sum of one dollar the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged.
