This Deed made this 19th day of October 1866, between Joseph T Beaman the grantor of the one part and Luther R Edwards trustee of the other part, Witnesseth: that the said Joseph T Beaman doth grant unto Luther R Edwards the following property, to wit, four beds and furniture, three beds and furniture, four mattresses, one bureau, one washstand, one wardrobe, wardrobe No 2, one table, one dozen chairs, two rocking chairs, lot of crockery, lot of kitchen furniture, one clock, one hot rack, lot of pails and buckets, eleven sheats, one sor. one bay horse, one cart and wheels one buggy and harness In trust to secure a bond due Jordan Edwards for eight hundred dollars, due about the year 1856.
