This Deed this 27th day of October, one thousand eight hundred and sixty six, between John D. Myrick, and Marie C. his wife residents of the City of Norfolk and State of Virginia (but at present, and temporarily sojourning in the City of Baltimore, Maryland), of the one part & John R. Kelley, of Suffolk, Accomack County, Virginia, chosen as trustee, for the purposes herein after named, of the second part. Witnesseth, that the said John D. Myrick and Marie C. his wife, do grant with general warranty, unto the said John R. Kelley, Trustee as aforesaid, the following real and other estate, to wit: 1st a lot or parcel of land in Norfolk City, aforesaid, on the West side of Market Square, & on which the house has been destroyed by fire: and also all policies or other claims for insurance on the houses so burnt and due by the Mutual Assurance Society of Virginia (subject to a deed of trust heretofore executed by said John D. Myrick to Caswell Taylor, Trustee for Mrs. Mary C. Elden & recorded in the Clerk's Office of Norfolk City, and also subject to several docketed judgments rendered in the Courts of Norfolk City - 2^d a tract of Swamp land in Norfolk County Virginia, known as "the Fort land" containing five thousand acres more or less - one moiety whereof is subject to a deed of trust executed by said John D. Myrick & wife to Hader Biggs Trustee for Walter Myrick & is of record in the Clerk's Office of Norfolk County Court, and is also subject to several docketed judgments, as docketed in the Clerk's Office of Norfolk County Court - 3^d Twenty three hundred acres of land in Southampton County, Virginia, near Newsums Depot, and including the dwelling and Store house at said Depot, and the Newsum place - the old place, the mill & privileges, the place occupied by John Pope & others, and a lot at Monroe and the Ferry franchise across Appomattox River (all of which real estate in Southampton County aforesaid is subject to a deed of trust executed by said John D. 8th All his (the said John D. Myrick's) Stock in the Atlantic Hotel Company & all dividends now due or that may hereafter become due.

9th One Stallion and one buggy -

10th A bond due by Rich^d H. Baker & Richard H. Baker Jr. (amount due being eight hundred dollars, more or less - whatever the same may be it is hereby conveyed -

11th All moneys that may be due by W^m White for timber cut on the said Fort land

12th Any balance that may be due from Rents of lands in Southampton County, after paying to John D. Myrick, any balance due him on a Settlement of his accounts as agent in attending to said lands & other matters -
