Wtchmstl. that in consideration of three hundred and twenty five dollars, the said Benjamin G. Turner doth grant unto the said Richard Harris all his right and title to a certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and sixty acres (more or less) & bounded as follows, by the lands of Mr. St. Thomas, Mr. Henry Moore & Mr. David Harris, it being the tract of land formerly owned by James Turner Esq. The said grantor covenants to warrant generally the property hereby conveyed. Witness the following signature & seal

This Deed made this 7th day of October in the year one thousand eight hundred sixty three between John Joyner & Nancy his wife of the one part and Sife Blanchett of the other part all of the County of Northampton et. C. Wtchmstl. that the said John Joyner & Nancy Joyner his wife for & in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars paid to the said John Joyner by the said Sife Blanchett, the receipt whereof the said John Joyner doth hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained and sold to the said Sife Blanchett grant, bargan, sell & convey to the said Sife Blanchett our entire interest in a certain tract of land known as the Jack Jordan place lying in the County of Southampton State of Va. Bounded by the lands of John H. Argue & supposed to contain one hundred twenty five acres but make & not whether there be more or less together with all & every privilege, right and appurtenances belonging to the said tract or parcel of land. To have and to hold our interest in the lands and all the privileges, rights and appurtenances belonging thereto unto him the said Sife Blanchett his heirs & assigns in fee simple, and him the said Sife Blanchett the said tract of land hereby conveyed together with all & every privilege right & appurtenances thereto belonging against the claim & demands of him the said John Joyner and Nancy Joyner his wife & their heirs and against the claims & demands of all & every other person claiming or to claim in right of him the said John Joyner & Nancy Joyner his wife and that the said John Joyner & Nancy Joyner his wife
