

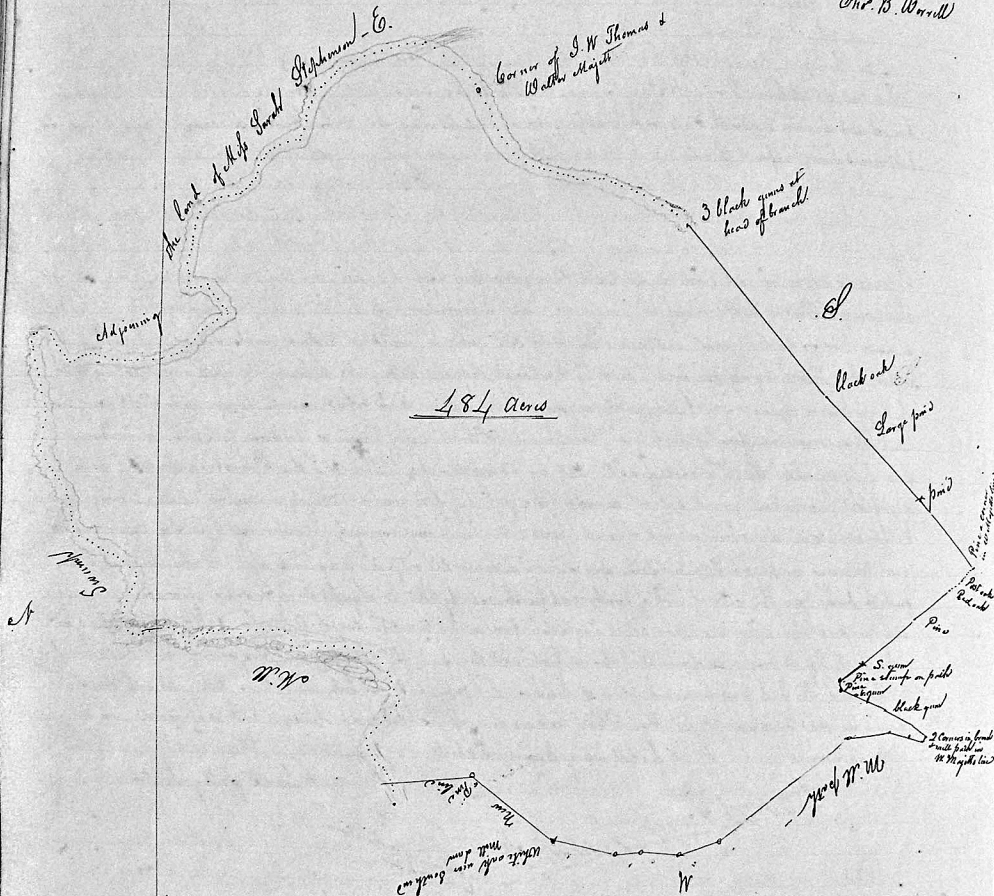

This Deed made this 17th day of December one thousand eight hundred and sixty six between George H. Fogg of the County of Southampton of the one part and Leroy R. Kilby Trustee for the purpose herein of the other part. Witnesseth that the said George H. Fogg, does grant with general warranty unto the said Leroy R. Kilby Trustee as aforesaid the following real estate, to wit, a tract of land in the County of Southampton containing four hundred and eighty four acres, and also a piece of twenty four acres adjoining, and which parcels of land were this day purchased of John R. Kilby Trustee for John D. Myrick, and adjoin the lands of Sarah Stephenson, Walter Myrick,
