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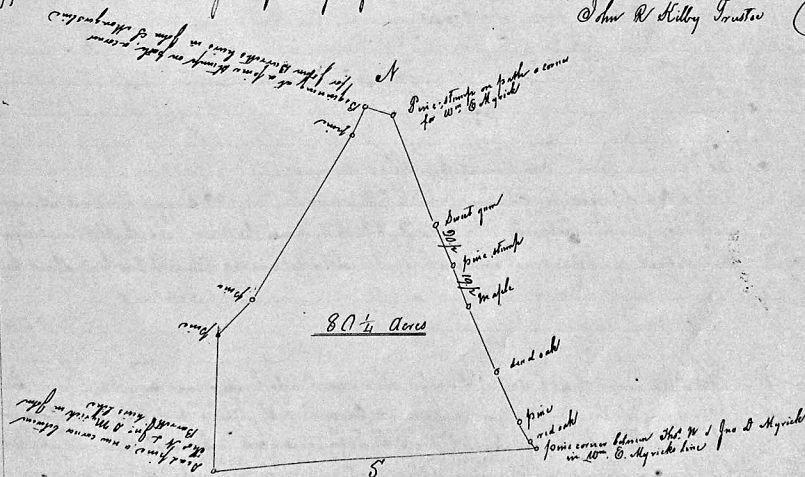

And whereas in execution of said trust, he, the said John R Kilby trustee as aforesaid, proceeded to advertise the sale of said lands by printed handbills and by advertisements published within "Petersburg Index" and "Norfolk Virginian" and did on Monday the 17th day of December 1866 at Jansdown in said County (being Court day) sell at auction a tract of land (part of the lands thus conveyed) containing by survey eighty and a quarter acres, and as will more fully appear by plat annexed, adjoining the lands of Wm. C Myrick and others: and at such sale the said parcel of land was purchased by Wm. C Myrick at eight dollars per acre, making six hundred and forty two dollars.
