Whereas John D. Myrick and Maria C. his wife by their deed of trust, dated the 26<sup>th</sup> May 1866 and recorded in the County of Southampton, did convey, unto Hader Biggs, as trustee for Walter Myrick among other estates the said Myrick with Mill property; and whereas also the said John D. Myrick and Maria C. his wife by another deed of trust dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of October 1866 and duly recorded in the said County, did convey unto John W. Kelley trustee thereof named, among other property his "Mill and privileges" and whereas by the last named deed it is provided that the said John W. Kelley trustee as aforesaid shall proceed as speedily as practicable to make sale of and collect the debts thereby conveyed, and he is expressly empowered to make sale of all or any part of the property thus conveyed, at public or private sale and on such terms and conditions as he might deem best: and whereas in execution of said trusts, the said John W. Kelley and Hader Biggs trustees as aforesaid did proceed to advertise by printed hand bills and by advertisements published in the "Pulsbury India" and "Norfolk Virginian" and did on Monday the 17<sup>th</sup> day of December 1866, at Jerusalem, in said County of Southampton (being County Court day) sell at public auction the mill belonging to said John D. Myrick with all its rights, privileges & a small parcel of land of about eighteen acres and which is by plat annexed more fully described and is called this acre, which is reduced to eighteen acres because of error in survey of Martha Stephenson's line and at such sale Harrison P. Spof became the purchaser thereof at the price of thirteen hundred and thirty dollars, one fourth cash and the balance at twelve months credit with interest from date. Therefore this deed made the 17<sup>th</sup> day of December 1866 between the said John W. Kelley and Hader Biggs, trustees as aforesaid of the one part, and the said Harrison P. Spof of the other part, Witnesseth, that the parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of thirteen hundred and thirty dollars, do grant with special warranty unto the said Harrison P. Spof and to his heirs and assigns, forever the said mill and rights, privileges, and the said parcel of eighteen acres of land more or less, sold as aforesaid and referred to in said plat.
