This Deed made this 24th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty six, between Elmyra A. Ricks widow of Alfred Ricks deceased, Richard A. Ricks, Mary W. Ricks, Walter A. Ricks and Ella T. Ricks of Caroline County State of Virginia, and Julia W. Winston and Bowling H. Winston her husband of Southampton County State of Virginia, Deborah R. Postlow and John Postlow her husband of Southampton County State of Virginia, parties of the first part and Elizabeth C. White wife of O. Dwin White of Southampton County State of Virginia, party of the second part, witnesseth that the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five hundred (\$2500) dollars in hand paid by the party of the second part, do hereby grant with special warranty to the said party of the second part all their right title or claim in or to the farm with the appurtenances known as "Blairmont" formerly the residence of Alfred Ricks deceased, and adjoining the lands of Jane Postlow, Elliott Gray, John Ellis and others containing four hundred and forty two acres more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton, State of Virginia and now occupied by O. Dwin White. Said farm belonging to the estate of Alfred Ricks is now by a political division of said estate conveyed to one of the legatees, as her portion in said division, by the other parties interested in said estate. And the party of the first part do hereby covenant with the said party of the second part, that they have a good and lawful authority to relinquish and quit claim the sum, and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever claiming through or under us.
