

This Deed made the 19th day of October in the year 1864, between Joshua Bryant and his wife Mary Ann of one part and Samuel H. Griffin of the other part, witnesseth: that in consideration of the payment of One hundred dollars in bank money and one buggy and harness, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Joshua Bryant and Mary Ann his wife do grant bargain and sell unto the said Samuel H. Griffin all the right, title and interest they have in a certain tract or parcel of land recently purchased of the heirs of William Beale deceased known as the "old Beale place" and bounded on the North by the road leading from Murfrees Depot to Coyne's Church, on the East by the road leading from Coyne's Church to Franklin Depot and the lands of W. A. & S. H. Griffin and south by the lands of W. A. & S. H. Griffin and on the West by said W. A. & S. H. Griffin and Mrs. Evaline Drury, containing fifty one and one half acres, more or less, excepting the rights of said Beale's heirs to an half acre measuring from the center of the grave yard, all of which will fully appear by agreement to the record. In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals the day above written.
