This Deed made this 12th day of February eighteen hundred and sixty seven, between Lydia W Beale, George C Pope and Ann L his wife, and Lydia C Beale, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, of the one part, and William C Beale of the same County and State of the other part, Witnesseth: that the said Lydia W Beale, Geo. C Pope and Ann L his wife, and Lydia C Beale, in consideration of the sum of Twenty three hundred and fifty three dollars and thirty three cents (\$2353.33) to them in hand paid by the said William C Beale, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto him the said William C Beale his heirs and assigns forever, all their respective rights, titles and interest in and to a certain tract or parcel of land situated, lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of St. Lukes, containing seven hundred and six acres, be the same more or less. It being the tract of land of which Normann W Beale died possessed, the said Lydia W Beale being entitled to one sixth, George C Pope and Ann L to one sixth and Lydia C Beale to two sixths, and bounded by the lands of W. C. Beale, H. C. Pope, G. W. Fries and others. To have and to hold, the aforesaid rights, titles and interest of the said Lydia W Beale, George C Pope and Ann L his wife and Lydia C Beale in and to the above described tract or parcel of land, unto him the said William C.
