This Deed made and entered into the 19th day of February in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and sixty seven between James Darden and Sarah Darden his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, of the one part and Harrison P. Pope, of the same County and State of the other part, Witneseth; that the said James Darden & Sarah & his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred and forty eight dollars to them in hand paid by the said Harrison P. Pope, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto him the said Harrison P. Pope his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Lukes, containing by a late Survey One hundred and six acres, be the same more or less. It being part of the tract of land which the said James Darden lately purchased at the sale of the land of Mr. A. Myrick and bounded as follows, beginning in the run of a large branch at the mouth of the fish pond branch, a new corner for said Darden in said P. Pope's line, thence down the run of the branch to the road, thence along the road 89 1/4 poles to the mill path, thence along the mill path 75 poles to a corner for Caswell Worrell's heirs, thence along said Worrell's line at 86 8 1/2 poles, thence at 5° E 37 poles to a black gum at fork of branch, thence up the Eastly run to a pine & pine stump, thence 24 1/2° E 16 1/2 poles to a pine, thence 5 27° E 39 1/2 poles to a new corner for the parties in said Worrell's line, thence along a new line S 68° W 180 1/2 poles to a corner, thence at 22° W 7 poles to a pine, thence at 28° N 38 poles to the center of the fish pond, thence down the middle of the pond and run of branch below the dam to the beginning. To have and to hold the above described tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said Harrison P. Pope his heirs and assigns forever to and for their only proper use and benefit
