

This plat represents the tract of land Harrison P. Pepe purchased of James J Darden and bounded as follows. Beginning at the run of a large branch at the mouth of the fish pond branch in said H.P. Pepe's line; thence down the run of the branch to the road; thence along the road 89 $\frac{1}{4}$ rods to the mill pond; thence along the mill pond 75 rods to corner for Caswell Worrell's heirs; thence along this line N 26° E 28 $\frac{1}{2}$ rods; thence N 3° E 37 rods to black pine at fork of branches; thence up the west of the Eastly Prong of the branch to a pine and pine stump at the head of the branch; thence S 24° E 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ rods to a pine; thence S 24° E 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ rods to a new corner for the parties in Worrell's line; thence along a new line of marked trees S 68° W 180 $\frac{1}{2}$ rods to a corner; thence N 22° W 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ rods to a pine; thence N 20° W 38 rods to the center of the fish pond; thence down the middle of the pond and down the run of the branch to the beginning.
