 seven between Davis Ferguson (grantor) of the one part and George W Whitfield, Trustee, of the
 other part both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said
 Davis Ferguson doth grant unto the said George W Whitfield, Trustee, the following property
 to wit. One work ox, One Cart and one pair Cart wheels. In trust, to secure the payment of
 a certain debt due to Richard L Bryant by said bearing even date with this Deed of trust
 for the sum of twenty eight dollars and seventy five cents. Signed by the said Davis
 Ferguson. But if it should become necessary to sell the said Property for the payment of said
 debt the said Trustee is to give ten or more days notice of the time and place of sale by
 advertisements at two or more public places in the neighbourhood and shall sell the said
 property to the highest bidder for cash or so much thereof as may be sufficient for the purpose
 and after paying all expenses attending the execution of this trust, shall pay to the said
 Richard L Bryant the said sum of twenty eight dollars and 75¹⁰⁰ cents and the accruing
 interest thereon. And the surplus if any shall pay over to the said Davis Ferguson or his order.
