This Deed made and entered into this the 23^d day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty four (1864) between George A. Holliman and Octavia his wife of the one part, all of the County of Surry and State of Virginia. Witnesses: that whereas the said George A. Holliman died by last bearing date April 15th 1864 and admitted to record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County on the 18th day of April 1864, which will appear by reference to said deed in consideration whereof in all his lands lying in Southampton County most of which are therein particularly described. And whereas the said Octavia, wife of the said George A. Holliman did convey her interest in said lands mentioned in the aforesaid deed of April 15th 1864, and now being desirous of conveying her interest in all of said lands to the said Robert J. Morris, of the sum of Eight thousand dollars to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do grant and convey unto the said Robert J. Morris, his heirs and assigns, all the lands lying in Southampton County Va. which lands the said George A. Holliman held from his Father George A. Holliman, said lands described somewhat in the following manner: 1st The said Holliman tract on which Mr. B. Hall now resides and bounded on the West by the "Proctors road" on the East by the lands of P. D. Holmes and James H. Ungers and others. On the South by the of the said Ungers and others. On the North by the lands of R. D. Bailey and P. D. Holmes. Said tract containing One hundred and fifty acres, more or less - 2^d The Sylvia Holliman tract bounded on the East by the "Proctors road" on the South by the lands of P. D. Holmes, on the West by the lands of P. D. Drew, on the North by the lands of Robert D. Bailey. Said tract contains one hundred acres more or less - 3^d The "Washington tract" bounded on the South by the lands of P. D. Bailey, on the North by the lands of Henry D. Bailey, on the East by the lands of Robert Nelson and Mass. Warren. On the West by the "Proctors road" and intersected by said road, said tract containing fifty acres more or less - 4th "Waddle tract" bounded on the West by Isaac's Swamp, on the South by Charles land, on the East by the Road leading from the Proctors road to Iron Ditch, on the North by the Proctors road, said tract contains twenty acres more or less, all of which said lands herein described the said George A. Holliman and Octavia his wife do grant and convey unto the said Robert J. Morris. To have and to hold the same to him and his heirs forever. And the said grantors, do covenant that the said Robert J. Morris shall have quiet possession of said lands. And the said grantors do further agree that they will warrant generally the premises hereby conveyed.
