This Deed Made and Executed the 1st day of September Eighteen hundred and Sixty Six, between
William R. Lawrence of the County of Nansemond and State of Virginia of the one part, and Arthur
E. Hall of the County and State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth; That the said William R. Law-
rence is justly indebted to W^m. M. Jones by three bonds, bearing dates as follows, first May 1st
1854, second Oct. 1st 1855, third January 2^d 1856, amounting to Three thousand five hun-
dred dollars, and to Jonas W. Lawrence in the sum of Two thousand dollars as per bond
bearing date, August 1st 1856, which debts the said William R. Lawrence is willing and
desires to sever. Now therefore This Deed further witnesseth That the said William R. Lawrence
for and in Consideration of the sum of One dollar, to him in hand paid by the said Arthur
E. Hall, at or before the issuing and delivery of this present, (the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged), has bargained and sold, released and confirmed unto the said Arthur E. Hall, a certain
tract or parcel of Land, lying and being in the County of Southampton and State aforesaid, adjoining the lands
of Cecil C. Vaughan, W^m. C. Copeland and the Bonds of James T. Moore due, (containing) One hundred and
Sixty Six acres, more or less, together with the Stock of goods, wares and Merchandise now in the
said Franklin in said County of Southampton, upon them. And the said Arthur E. Hall
shall at any time after the 1st day of April 1857, after advertising the lands, goods
wares and Merchandise before mentioned as required by law, sell the same to the
highest bidder, for Cash, and out of the money arising from such sale, after paying
the expenses thereof, he shall pay to the said W^m. M. Jones and Jonas W. Lawrence the aforesaid
debts and the balanced (if any), he shall pay to the said William R. Lawrence, or to his heirs.
In witness whereof the said William R. Lawrence has hereunto set his hand and Seal the day
and year as first above written.
