This Indenture Made this 7th day of December 1866, between Richard Barrett and Mary R. Barrett his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part, and James W. Lawrence of the County of Hanover and State aforesaid of the other part, Constituted, That for the consideration of two hundred dollars in hand paid to the said Barrett and wife by the said Lawrence, the said Barrett & wife doth Sell the said Lawrence two certain Lots of Land in the Village of Franklin County of Southampton and State aforesaid. Containing One half of an acre each. The first Lot bounded as follows: Commencing at a Stone pipe buried at the North Corner of the Lot known as the Lot which William Murphey formerly bought of A. W. Norfleur and in which Bonds Dillard & Co. is at present doing business, thence along the line of the said Lot in a Southwesterly direction One hundred and five feet, thence in a Northwesterly direction two hundred and ten feet, thence in a Northeasterly direction One hundred and five feet to the Vacancy left for a road or Street, thence in a Southeasterly direction two hundred and ten feet to the Stone pipe the place of beginning. Making One half acre of Land. Second Lot bounded as follows: Commencing Thirty feet across the road or Street from the aforesaid Stone pipe and a west corner of the Lot formerly owned by Dr. Cox, thence along the line of the said road or Street in a Northwesterly direction two hundred and ten feet, thence in a Northeasterly direction One hundred and five feet, thence in a Southeasterly direction two hundred and ten feet to the aforesaid Cox's line, thence along the said Cox's line in a Southwesterly direction One hundred and five feet to the place of beginning. Making One half of an acre of Land. The right and title to the aforesaid Lots of Land, the said Barrett & wife warrants generally to the said Lawrence his heirs and assigns forever.
