

Suffolk County. In the Clerk's Office. September 15th 1867.

This Deed of Trust from Wm R Lawrence to Arthur E Hale for the benefit of Wm M. Jones and Jonas W. Lawrence was presented and registered with the Certificate of the Commissioner of Wm R. Lawrence, a party thereto, before Justice of the Peace, was admitted to record Stamps of the Internal Revenue of the United States of the amount of Eight dollars and fifty cents being affixed thereto, and duly Canceled. -

This Indenture Made this 7th day of December 1866, between Richard Barrett and Mary R. Barrett his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part, and James W. Lawrence of the County of Nansemond and State aforesaid of the other part, Constituting
Star 10th 1868.

Witness for the Consideration of two hundred dollars in hand paid to the said Barrett and wife by the said Lawrence, the said Barrett & wife doth Give the said Lawrence two certain Lots of Land in the Village of Franklin County of Southampton and State aforesaid. Containing one half of an acre each. The first Lot bounded as follows; Commencing at a Stone pipe buried at the North corner of the Lot bounded as the Lot which William Murfey formerly bought of A. W. Norfleet and on which Rands Dillard & Co. is at present doing business, thence along the line of the said Lot in a Southwesterly direction one hundred and five feet, thence in a Northwestwesterly direction two hundred and ten feet, thence in a Northeastwesterly direction one hundred and five feet to the Vacancy left for a road or Street, thence in a Southeastwesterly direction two hundred and ten feet to the Stone pipe the place of beginning. Making one half acre of Land. Second Lot bounded as follows; Commencing Thirty feet across the road or Street from the aforesaid Stone pipe and a west corner of the Lot formerly owned by Dr. Cox, thence along the line of the said road or Street in a Northwestwesterly direction two hundred and ten feet, thence in a Northeastwesterly direction one hundred and five feet, thence in a Southeastwesterly direction two hundred and ten feet to the aforesaid Cox's line, thence along the said Cox's line in a Southwestwesterly direction one hundred and five feet to the place of beginning, Making one half of an acre of Land. The right and Title to the aforesaid Lots of Land, the said Barrett & wife warrants generally to the said Lawrence his heirs and assigns forever.
