Lawrence, of Nansemond County and State aforesaid of the other part; Conditioned for the consideration of, four hundred dollars in hand paid to the aforesaid R. Barrett and Mary R. his wife. They doth bargain and sell to him his heirs and assigns One Certain Lot of land in the Village of Franklins Depot in the County of Southampton and State aforesaid lying on the South Side of the Seaboard and Roanoke rail road and on the East Side of the Spoor track running to the Steamboat wharf, Commencing 155 feet from the Center of the rail road land and three feet from the little Spoor track running to the Steamboat and the Corner of a Lot belonging to Joshua Durlow and running in a North-easterly Course 210 feet along the said Durlow's line, thence in a Southerly direction 105 feet, thence back to the little rail road track 210, thence 105 feet up the said track to the beginning, Making half acre of Land, the right and title Barrett & wife warrants to the aforesaid Lawrence generally.
