This Deed made this 28<sup>th</sup> day of September 1867, between Leonard C. Cobb, Trustee of  
the one part and Alvin Raiford of the other part both of the County of Southampton and State  
of Virginia. Witness that whereas on the 27<sup>th</sup> day November 1858, Alvin Raiford conveyed  
by deed recorded in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County, the tract of Land on which  
he now resides, to Andrew J. Kello, Trustee to secure the payment of a bond of \$900.00  
due Robert H. Vick, it being for the amount of the purchase money for said Land and said  
bonds, and whereas the said Alvin Raiford has since paid off and completely satisfied the  
requirements of said debt, as is evidenced by the bond properly accepted by Robert H. Vick.  
And whereas Alvin Raiford now desires a release deed for said Land, and whereas Andrew  
J. Kello, the Trustee has since died, and Leonard C. Cobb was appointed in his stead by  
an Order at the last September term of the County Court of Southampton County, who is  
now willing to execute the release deed to said Raiford for said Land, the debt secured  
under it having been satisfied. Now therefore, this deed testifies that the said Leon-  
ard C. Cobb, Trustee for and in consideration of the premises, and in the further sum of  
one dollar no hands paid by the said Alvin Raiford, doth grant, release and recon-  
vey unto him all of his right title and interest, to the tract of Land on which  
the said Raiford now resides, (and which was conveyed to Andrew J. Kello, former  
Trustee) with Special warranty. And the said Leonard C. Cobb doth hereby release  
unto the said Alvin H. Raiford all claim whatever to said property. Witness the
