

This Deed Made the 21st day of October in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and Sixty Seven, between Joseph A. Drury of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part, and John J. Turner of the same County and State of the other part. Whereas it is agreed that the said Joseph A. Drury for and in Consideration of the sum of One hundred and Ninety four dollars to him in hand paid by the said John J. Turner, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained, and sold, and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell unto him the said John J. Turner, his heirs and assigns forever, One certain tract, or parcel of Land, Situate, lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of Saint Luke's Containing by a late Survey thirty two and one third acres, in the same more or less, and bounded as follows. Beginning in William H. Drury's line, a short distance North of a black gum Stump Standing on the East Side of the path leading from Drewrysville to said William H. Drury's, thence along a line line S. 78° E. 55 $\frac{1}{2}$ poles to a small ash, at corner, thence N. 4° E. 117 poles to a pine, at new corner in said William H. Drury's line, thence along his line West 34 $\frac{1}{2}$ poles to a black gum Standing in a small branch, thence down the branch and along said William H. Drury's line of marked trees to the beginning so here and to hold the above described tract or parcel of land and premises with the appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said John J. Turner, his heirs and assigns forever; and the said Joseph A. Drury for himself, his heirs, Executors, Administrators, doth hereby Covenants and agree with the said John J. Turner, his heirs, Executors, Administrators and assigns, that he will by these presents warrant and forever defend all the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises against the claims or demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever. Know all Men by these presents that I Miles Worrell of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, in Consideration of love and affection which I bear to my Grand Children, Modia F. Griffin, Edwin E. Griffin and Martha A. Griffin, as well as the further Consideration of the sum of One dollar, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I have given granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto my said Grand Children their heirs and assigns forever, One certain tract or parcel of Land Situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton, and parish of St. Luke's, Containing by an estimation One Hundred acres, more or less, and bounded as follows: Making a corner at the ditch on the fish road, just below my house, then down the fish road to Ben R. Griffin's line, following which in a Southern direction until arriving at Ben Worrell's line, from thence to Lewis Dick's line in the branch, thence returning through the lane which divides the land now given away, from Lewis Dick's estate, thence up the fence to the branch, and return to the first corner spoken of on the fish road. And I the said Miles Worrell, for myself, my heirs, Executors and Administrators, do hereby Covenant and agree with my said Grand Children above named, their heirs Executors, Administrators or assigns, that I will by these presents warrant and forever defend, all the right and title of the above described tract or parcel of Land against the claims or demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever.
