That for the consideration of Sixty five dollars in hand paid to them the said Richard Barrett and Mary R. Barrett his wife, doth sell to the said Messrs R. J. and W. N. J. one certain lot of Land lying on the North Side of the Seaboard and Roanoke Rail Road and near the Villages of Franklin Depot, Southampton County and State of Virginia, bounded as follows, Commencing at a piece of iron buried fifty feet from the Centre of the said S. & R. R. Track, thence in a Northwesterly direction one hundred and five feet to a pine tree chopped, thence in a Southwesterly direction four hundred and twenty feet to another pine tree chopped, thence in a Southeasterly direction one hundred and five feet to another pine tree chopped standing fifty feet from the Centre of the aforesaid S. & R. R. Track, thence up the line of said S. & R. R. four hundred and twenty feet to the piece of iron buried at the place of Commencement. Making one acre of Land.
