This Deed made this fifth day of December in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty
Six, between Samuel Dardon and Sarah S. Dardon his wife, of the first party, and Abdon-
imus Williams of the other party, witnesseth, that the said Samuel Dardon & Sarah S.
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and fifty dollars to the
said Dardon & wife, this day paid, the receipt of which sum is hereby acknowledged,
do grant and convey to the said A. Williams, all that tract or parcel of Land,
lying at "Piney Grove" in Southampton County, supposed to contain Eighteen and a
half acres, more or less, and bounded as follows, to wit; At the North West, by the
Road called the "Boni's road" leading from the Piney Grove to Boni's Bridge, to North
B. Butler's line; thence from a pine a corner tree, a straight line along said Butler's
line to a Post Oak; thence along said Butler's line of marked trees to a Survey Post,
thence along said Butler's line to a Second Gum; thence from said tree to the
fish road, to eastward; thence up said fish road parallel with the lot of land
whereon now stands the Methodist Church, called "Barren"; thence along the
line of said Church Land around to the Rock on the North side of said Church;
thence up said road to the confluence of the Fish road with the aforesaid Boni's road.—
And the said Samuel Dardon and Sarah S. Dardon his wife, warranty generally the
