

This Indenture made this the 26<sup>th</sup> day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & forty seven between Isaac Pipkin and George M. Pipkin his wife of the County of Bertie & State of North Carolina parties of the first party & Arthur R. Edwards of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia (deceased) party of the second party Wilkesboro. That whereas one John P. Smith now deceased of the said County of Southampton and State of Virginia did by Last Will and Testament devise or certain tract of Land Situate in Southampton County aforesaid to Isaac Pipkin aforesaid, & whereas said John P. Smith inherited said Land from his Mother Martha G. Smith & whereas said Isaac Pipkin was named in said Will as Executor & regularly qualified as such in the Court of the County of Southampton aforesaid & gave as his Seal to James Vaughan & John P. Smith was at the time of his death indebted to Mr. Chapman in the sum of One hundred & ten dollars or thereabouts, & said John P. Smith was at the time of his death indebted to Arthur E. Hall in the sum of Forty five dollars or thereabouts & the said Martha G. Smith at the time of her death was indebted to William Lawrence in the sum of Three hundred & fifty dollars or thereabouts, & whereas the said John P. and Martha G. Smith were indebted to the said John P. Smith as above aforesaid, & whereas the said Isaac Pipkin as Executor & devised is anxious to pay off & discharge the aforesaid debts and has heretofore his aforesaid Seal thereto affixed. Wherefore this Indenture further Whereas that for the above considerations & for the further Consideration of the sum of ten dollars to the said Isaac Pipkin & George M. Pipkin in their hands paid by the said Arthur R. Edwards the receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged by the said Isaac Pipkin & George M. Pipkin his wife here now granted, bargained, sold, exchanged & delivered, & by these presents do give, grant, bargains, sell, exchange & deliver unto the said Arthur R. Edwards his heirs & assigns a part of the aforesaid tract of Land, lying & Situated in Southampton County State of Virginia bounded as follows: to wit, On the North by the South Fork Creek, on the East by the Cherry Creek Ferry Road, on the South by the Blackwater River, and on the West by the head of the Cypress Swamp, containing two hundred acres more or less, to hold to him the said Lands, tenements, &c. waggons, rents, hereditaments & appurtenances thereunto belonging, to him the said Arthur R. Edwards his heirs & assigns forever in fee simple, upon the Special trust & Condition whereof that if the aforesaid debts are not paid off & discharged within three years from the date of this Deed by the said Isaac Pipkin or by some one for him, then & in that case said Arthur R. Edwards his heirs & assigns first being & entitled to do so by the said Isaac Pipkin and the aforesaid Isaac Loring & James Vaughan, shall advertise the aforesaid parcel of Land for the space of thirty days & then sell the same to the highest bidder for cash or credit as directed by said Isaac Pipkin, & paid the proceeds arising therefrom he shall first pay off the expenses of this trust, & then pay off & discharge the aforesaid debts & finally if any funds should remain in his the said Trustee's hands he shall pay over all such funds or Money so remaining in his hands to the said Isaac Pipkin & George M. Pipkin their heirs & assigns. In testimony whereof the said Isaac Pipkin & George M. Pipkin, his wife do humble set their hands and seals the day and date first above written.
