

This Deed made the 18th day of January in the year 1868, between John S. Hubbard
of the one party and John Taylor of the other party, both of the County of Southampton in
State of Virginia, Witnesseth that in Consideration of the sum of Two hundred & fifty
dollars in hand paid by the said John Taylor, the receipt whereof is hereby ac-
knowledged, the said John S. Hubbard doth grant bargain & sell unto the
said John Taylor, all his right title & interest to a certain tract or parcels
of land lying and being in the County of Southampton, Containing two hundred
and Sixty acres more or less, it being the land now occupied by the
said John S. Hubbard, the right thereto Convey'd is my right
in said land. Witness my hand and seal this day & date above written.
