County of Southampton State of Virginia of the first part and Luther R. Edwards of the
County and State aforesaid of the Second part, witnesseth: That in Consideration of the
Sum of One thousand five hundred dollars paid to the aforesaid Jordan Edwards,
he does bargain to sell to the aforesaid Luther R. Edwards one certain tract of
lands lying in the County of Southampton State of Virginia bounded as follows; on the
East by the lands of Timothy Langston Debnorth & George Camp, Henry V. Gott, George
W. Camp & that portion of the lands owned by me lying directly on the east and southward
boundary of the path & lane leading from the junction of Franklin road & running west
and southward to the field known as the Fenton field, through the woodland on the South
east side of the farm, to the Seaboard and Rockw. Rail Road; on the South by the lands of
John H. Corp & the Gardner tract; on the West by the lands of Geo. B. Langston, B. M.
Cannell, John Williams & Wiley H. & Samuel H. Griffis, & on the North by the lands
of Timothy Langston, it being the whole of the tract on which I now live except that
portion lying South of the lands of George W. Camp, and East & Southeast of the aforesaid
path from the junction of Franklin road to the Seaboard & Rockw. Rail road,
containing four hundred acres, more or less, to have & to hold forever. The aforesaid
Jordan Edwards warranting the title generally given under my hands and seal
