Edwards of the County and State aforesaid of the Second part, Witnesseth: That in Consideration of the Sum of One thousand four hundred dollars paid to the aforesaid Jordan Edwards, he does bargain & sell to the aforesaid Luther P. Edwards one Certain Tract of Land lying in the County of Southampton State of Virginia bounded as follows, on the East by the Lands of Timothy Langston, Deceased & George Baynes, Henry V. Goff, George W. Camp & that portion of the Land owned by me lying directly on the east and southeasterly boundary of the said Land heading from the Jerusalem & Franklin roads & running westerly and southerly to the field known as the Parker field, through the woodland on the south east side of the same, to the Seaboard and Norfolk Rail Road; on the South by the Lands of John H. Goff & the Gardner tract; on the West by the Lands of Geo. B. Langston, Deceased, John Williams & Wiley H. & Samuel H. Chiffon, & on the North by the Land of Timothy Langston, it being the whole of the tract on which I now live except that portion lying South of the Land of George W.
