Ninety Nine cents, the Balance of the purchase money, payable as directed by said Deed, and witness  
by a further Deed made in the said Court at October, anno 1861, of said Court. It was further  
agreed & ordered, that W<sup>m</sup> H. Jayne, Commissioner as aforesaid receive of the Estate of said  
Court the Bond executed by said W<sup>m</sup> Mahone, bearing date the 17<sup>th</sup> of November 1860, for \$989.90.

aforesaid, and in further execution of said last named Deed, does grant with Special  
Warranty unto the said William Mahone and to his heirs & assigns forever the said
