Preps, Trustees for the Berlin Masonic Lodge No. 39 of the other part. Witnesseth (That for and in consideration of the sum of thirty Dollars (\$30) the said Richard M. Stephenson and Martha his wife, doth grant and sell in a certain tract or parcel of Land situate within the Berlin Lodge stands containing by estimation one (1) acre more or less, bounded by the lands of M. S. Butler, Richard M. Stephenson, and W. A. Stephenson and the said Trustees to have it for the benefit and subject to the control of the Lodge.
