 Pond, God Council and others, it being the Lands given me by my Father in his
 last Will and Testament, that will warrant and defend the right to the

 Joseph Council doth grant unto the said Murdock M. Clayton the following prop-
 erty to wit: One bay horse, One calf and wheels, 1 Cow, 5 Hogs, 2 Sows, and 12
 Pigs and their future increase, 15 bbls. corn, 2000 lbs. black fodder, 1 bbl and
 furniture, all of the farming implements, his stock of pots or barrels about 800 lbs.
 1 Silver Watch, 1 clock, in trust to secure two bonds and Alfred S. Stephenson, executor
 of John Johnson's debt. One for the sum of One hundred and ninety & 50/100 dollars,
 due December 1st 1867, One due same for twenty dollars due June 1st 1867,
 One bond due A. S. Stephenson amount to Thos. B. Johnson dec. for twenty five.
